Agape Love, Tough and Tender

The interaction between Jesus and the man that we call the Rich Young Ruler in Mark 10 is filled with important lessons about faithfulness to God. Apparently, just keeping the commandments was not enough. Jesus told him to keep the commandments, the young man said that he had, and Jesus did not correct him. Instead, Jesus looked at the inquisitive seeker, but not like you and I would, rather, He examined his heart. Jesus saw something there that negated all the good things this young Jewish man had done. He saw that the man's great possessions owned him. Instead of using these blessings to honor God, they had captured his heart and he was unwilling to let them go.

One decision was all that separated this outwardly faithful keeper of the law from eternal life. The most telling lesson, in my mind, comes in verse 21, when Mark writes, "Jesus, looking at him, **loved him**." How did Jesus love him? He told him the truth about what he lacked, gave him a remedy, and let him make up his own mind. Jesus' love was both "tough" and "tender". He wept at Lazarus' tomb and over the city of Jerusalem and he let this man walk away without changing or bending the rules. He made it clear what would solve his problem and the man was unwilling to do it.

Likewise, at times our love needs to be "tough" and at other times "tender". Wisdom (via Jesus' example) and compassion helps us decide which is appropriate.

God bless and remember I love you and want to go to heaven with you.
