August Evangelism Update



This month, I wanted to share another common question that comes up in Bible studies which is “Why do you think you are the only ones going to heaven?” Some think it is arrogant or unloving to hold the position that there is only “one” church. The question we must ask, and answer, is not what we think, but what does the bible say about the matter. The following is the series of verses that I share with people about the uniqueness of the Lord’s church.

Ephesians 5:23-...**Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.**

Ephesians 1:22-23- ... **Him to be head over all things to the church, which is His body...**

Colossians 1:18- ... **He is the head of the body, the church...**

These three passages affirm that the body and the church are synonymous terms meaning that what is said about one is true about the other. Then we look at:

Ephesians 4:4- ... **There is one body...**

The fact that the church of Christ teaches that there is only one body, therefore there is only one church, should not be controversial at all; it is that clearly taught in God’s Word. The question then that must be answered is what does that mean?

Does it mean that there is one body made up of many beliefs and practices that vary from one another? Or does it mean that there is one body made up of one unified belief with unified practices. The only way to answer that is to let Scripture tell us. So, what does Scripture say?

Jesus prayed this in John 17: 20-21. *“I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.”*

Paul begged for this in 1 Corinthians 1:10. *“Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.”*

Is it arrogant or unloving to seek that which Jesus prayed for or that which Paul via inspiration begged for? Of course not. Then it is a matter of looking at what a church teaches and does to see if it matches what Scripture says.
