## Update on Our Ukraine Relief Project

The Russian invasion of Ukraine rages on. Each day there is more footage of bombings, families in turmoil, parents waving goodbye to their children as they serve in the Ukrainian army. Many of our Ukrainian brothers and sisters have been impacted by this invasion and our prayers are with them continually.

At the same time we have been involved. Our Ukraine Relief Project, featuring the family buckets and hygiene bags has really taken off. Our Chase Park family has been bringing buckets and hygiene products in weekly. Additionally, several sister congregations, students, teachers, and people within our community are participating in this effort. We have received numerous donations that are being sent to help support the church at Cherkassy, Ukraine, and their neighbors.

At the end of March we plan to have a sorting and packing project where we will pack all the hygiene products into gallon bags. There will be a bucket and bag loading party as we load the items onto a transport, as they will head to Poland. Once in Poland, the buckets and bags will be distributed to the Ukrainian refugees. Brethern, your efforts and service are greatly appreciated by so many. It is our hope and prayer that these buckets and bags will bring some relief and comfort to families who have endured so much. I'm so thankful for our Chase Park family and the involvement that is taking place throughout this month. You are commended on your efforts and desire to help.
