EVANGELISM UPDATE

October 2023

Since the last time I sent an update, a number of things have happened. We have sent funds to Maui, Hawaii, to assist in Disaster Relief and Evangelistic efforts.

We have had at least two baptisms and we currently have at least 11 studies ongoing. The majority of those are being conducted by members of the congregation. Recently, I wrote about Angela Ireland studying with someone over Zoom and that person being baptized. Similarly, yesterday, our son-in-law, Chandler, got two calls, one from South Carolina and one from Alabama from preachers who were studying on-line with folks in Asheboro, NC (where Chandler, Sarah, and Rilla live).

Chandler contacted one of the students, met him at the church building, studied with him, and then baptized him into Christ. He is working on setting something up with the second student as well.

These kinds of prospects are few and far between and we are so thankful when good-hearted people (Matthew 7:7-9) come in contact with someone who can guide them (Acts 8:31) into the truth. I am asking that all of us send this young man a card welcoming him to the family of God. He is part of a family business that has him on the road most of the time from state to state and it will be hard for him to be at one congregation consistently. He needs us to encourage him.
