

This past week we were blessed to have Hiram Kemp and his family with us at Chase Park. Hiram did an excellent job in conducting our Gospel Meeting throughout the week. We had good attendance and greatly benefitted from the Bible studies each night.

Our theme for the week centered upon *Reaching the Lost*. One of my favorite lessons Hiram presented to us this week came on Tuesday night and was entitled, *What to Look for in a Church*. The points within the sermon included,

What to Look for in a Church...

- A church preaching Jesus. (Acts 2:36)
- A church that preaches the Biblical plan of salvation. (Acts 2:37)
- A church that continues in the apostle's doctrine. (Acts 2:42)
- A church that is loving. (Acts 2:43-46)
- A place where the Lord adds members. (Acts 2:47)

As I considered this lesson and points, I evaluated our own congregation here at Chase Park. Here are a few things I have observed at Chase Park...

1. Each time we assemble together we hear the teachings of Jesus being presented. Whether from the pulpit, in a Bible class, in conversations, or within people's homes the Lord is on our hearts, minds and lips.
2. It is difficult for me to think of a time that the saving plan of the Lord is not given at Chase Park. At times we may think the plan of salvation is a traditional end to the sermon. Yet the plan of salvation is powerful and the way back to the Father. Romans 1:16 says, "...it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes." Thus it is vitally important for people to know.
3. Since Jesus' ascension into Heaven it was the apostles' responsibility to continue preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ. Throughout time the doctrine of Christ has been tested, mocked, and even tossed away by some. Yet the church family at Chase Park continues to preach, teach, and live according to the gospel of Christ. It is our standard in which we live by.
4. The doctrine of Jesus is important to live by, but without love it will mean nothing within the family and to the world. We must continue to love and be involved in one another's lives. Romans 12:15 states, "Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep." We must be a caring congregation in order to build our relationships with one another and the lost.
5. When the first 4 points all come together it is then the celebration begins. Adding individuals to the family of God through baptism is the greatest feeling. In 2021 we have had numerous individuals who have been interested in the Lord's kingdom. Several of you have studied with family members, coworkers, friends, etc. We have seen growth within our congregation. It is my prayer that we continue our journey of faith, live as we should, and teach others the gospel of Christ.

All in all we are a blessed people. Let us continue to be a loving, caring, and abiding family within the Lord.
