Since that time, there have been almost 200 people who have come to Christ through his efforts and the students at the Philogus School of Preaching in Sri Kakulum, Andhra Pradesh, India. They have been going into the state directly north of them, Odisha state, to evangelize and hold gospel meetings. This state is an extremely dangerous place for Christians and for those seeking the truth of God's Word. Please pray for him and his son, Uttam, and their current and past graduate students who are working diligently to reach the lost.

We have several people we are studying with at this time and have had several others who have started visiting our services. Please continue to do your great job of making these people feel welcome. Also, all of our New Mover and Welcome packets have been given out and we are putting more of them together. If you know of someone who is moving to the area or in your neighborhood, let me know and we will do our best to make them feel welcome.

In addition, we have families that are hurting because of the loss of loved ones; please reach out to them and show them the love of Christ as they grieve. We have friends of our congregation who have had damage to their house and property from a recent tornado. Their neighbor's house was heavily damaged and he was trapped under the rubble in his garage storm shelter. There were several members of Chase Park who showed up the next morning to help them clean up their property. The more we can show the love of God to our neighbors and coworkers, the better chance we have of getting them to agree to consider the gospel message.
