Lads to Leaders

Last weekend was the Lads to Leaders convention for 2023. For my family, it was the last convention for our children to participate as students in the program. My children have spent every Easter weekend of their lives at the Opryland Hotel with Lads to Leaders, and I am so thankful to be able to say that. What a blessing this program has been to them and to me! Allow me to share with you some thoughts and insights that I have concerning Lads to Leaders:

- **Lads to Leaders is not perfect.** I start with this because I know that there are some who are not fans of the program for one reason or another. Are there things that I would like to see changed? Yes. Are there people involved who do not always act as they should? Yes. Are there times when aspects of the program can be frustrating and even discouraging? Yes. But, even given all of this, there is no program associated with the Lord’s church that does what Lads to Leaders can do and does do successfully year after year—bring hundreds of congregations of the church together for the purpose of training, encouraging, and supporting thousands of its young people as they strive to become leaders for the Lord.
- **Lads to Leaders needs adults.** Even though this program is designed for and focused on children, it cannot exist or function without an army of adults. It seems ironic to me that a program that is made to train young people to lead often struggles on the congregational level because of a lack of adults who are willing or able to lead. One of the great aspects of this program is that while children graduate out of it, adults do not have to. Parents, empty-nesters, and grandparents can all be involved to make a difference in the lives of the congregation’s children.
- **Lads to Leaders has some hidden benefits.** While we are well aware of its purpose of training children to be leaders in the church, there are some other fantastic benefits of this program. For instance, it helps to create and nurture great relationships between the children and adults who are involved with the program. It also helps to foster relationships among the children. Both of these things help to grow a child’s village of Christian mentors, encouragers, and friends, adding strength and stability to their spiritual life.

There is so much more that I would like to say, but I am out of space. Let me encourage you to look for or ask about ways to be involved with this great program. And if you have never attended a convention, plan now to come to Nashville next year and witness it for yourself. I believe that you will be impressed and wowed by what you see.
