One Effort Ends and Another Begins

A little over a week ago we closed the book on our Ukraine Relief Project. On Wednesday, May 18, several Chase Park members gathered and loaded the shipping container bound for Ukraine. It took us two hours to load the container as all worked together and were eager to help.

The following are the total items that were collected for Ukraine refugees and loaded on the container: 765 family buckets, 244 medium and large boxes consisting of personal hygiene products, 34 tote bags of personal hygiene products, 43 small to medium boxes of medical supplies, 40 trash bags filled with shoes and blankets and 2 boxes of pots and pans.

The 40 foot shipping container was near full after loading. In addition, approximately \$30,000 was given to help with Ukraine Missions and Relief. Special thanks goes to our Chase Park family, sister congregations, our community, schools and businesses.

Thank you to Cody and Robbie Gothart who helped secure our shipping container and John Kachelman (Sam's brother) in helping with logistics. We are prayerful for the Ukrainian people and hope these items will be of some relief to them.

This week we begin another great work, our Chase Park Vacation Bible School. The Chase Park VBS will take place Wednesday through Friday, June 1—3. We are excited to welcome our students and community to our VBS and pray that it will be a success. Our theme for VBS is *Kingdom Quest* and we will be discovering who our true King is in life.

Our Children's Track will take place from 9:30 a.m.—11:30 a.m. Our Teen Track will run from 12:00 p.m.—8:00 p.m. We would love for your children, family, and/or neighbors to come and be with us!
