

Peace

(John 14:27)

At times, when we look around, it seems like everything around us involves trials, suffering, pain, grief, anguish and turmoil. It is heart breaking to us when we see so many suffering with these various difficulties, and it is doubly painful when they hit close to home, involving us or our family directly. If it weren't for one promise from Jesus, these conditions might be unbearable.

Jesus tells us in John 14:27 that he has left an amazing promise for us as we face the struggles of this life—**peace**. The consequences of sin are all around us, having robbed this present world of the paradise God had initially provided for His people, and the peace that was then known.

As we see these disheartening conditions encroaching upon and threatening us, there is an assurance which we are able to dwell upon and have a state of mind that is not available to those outside of Christ's body. The peace He has promised is based upon our submission to His will. Once we have transformed ourselves into the image He desires of us, He tells us in this passage, "Do not be troubled, Do not be afraid."

What a wonderful assurance we are given, that this world cannot hurt us spiritually, robbing us of a peaceful, confident state of mind or our eternity with God. Take refuge in the promise from Christ: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you."
