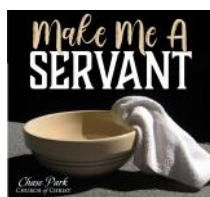

## Trust in the Lord

What do you use for your life's compass? No matter how insightful, wise, experienced, or knowledgeable we may be, only God can guide our steps properly. God asks us to trust Him and His wisdom even when we can't immediately see the rationale behind it. He wants us to recognize His presence, guidance, and grace in all we do. As we trust and as we acknowledge His presence, we suddenly realize that our path is a lot straighter, and our destination is a lot closer.

Consider the following passages and their encouragement for us to trust in the Lord:

**Proverbs 3:5-6.** *"<sup>5</sup>Trust in Jehovah with all your heart and lean not upon your own understanding; <sup>6</sup>in all your ways acknowledge Him, and he will direct your paths."*

**Jeremiah 10:23.** *"<sup>23</sup>O Jehovah, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walks to direct his steps."*

**1 Corinthians 1:20-21.** *"<sup>20</sup>Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? <sup>21</sup>For seeing that in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom knew not God, it was God's good pleasure through the foolishness of the preaching to save them that believe."*

Do we trust in our own ways, our own decisions in spiritual matters? If we do, we need to change our trust, placing it in our God as these verses teach.
