## But God

The Bible is filled with stories of people who were in very desperate situations. Often there seemed to be no solution to the problem that they faced. Then the Bible used a phrase that is often repeated, “but God.” It is a phrase that demonstrated that though the situation seems hopeless, God has a solution. In fact, if we’re honest, God is the solution.

Why do we so often leave God out of our plans; out of our solutions; out of our mind? In Genesis 6, man reached a point of wickedness that God could no longer tolerate. God was sorry that He had made man, but Noah found favor in God’s eyes. Noah obediently built the ark and God sent him the animals for him to bring onto the ark with him. Then the rains began and the waters of the deep were opened and the water covered everything and killed all of the men and animals not in the ark.

Genesis 8:1, *But God remembered Noah and all the beasts and all the cattle that were with him in the ark; and God caused a wind to pass over the earth, and the water subsided.* God who had provided a means to escape the flood initially also caused the flood to subside.

Psalms 49:7 gives a statement of the futility of trusting in our riches and trying to save the soul of my brother through my own effort or with my money. Psalms 49:7-9, *No man can by any means redeem his brother Or give to God a ransom for him— (8) For the redemption of his soul is costly, And he should cease trying forever— . Psalms 49:15, But God will redeem my soul from the power of Sheol, For He will receive me.* There is no solution for salvation from sin except God’s solution.

Romans 5:6-9, *For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. (7) For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. (8) But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (9) Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.*

Ephesians 2:3-7, *Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest. (4) But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, (5) even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), (6) and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, (7) so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.*

Without God our situation really is hopeless, but God gave His Son to win the victory over sin for us.
