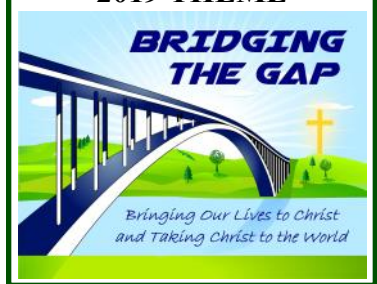

Outreach—Pat Cowden

A week ago yesterday we had our 9th OHM meeting with Team #11. We have had a total of 168 people in our home with 21 visitors. It has been a wonderful blessing to get to know our brothers and sisters better and to be given an avenue to invite friends to “come and see” what Christian fellowship can and should be like.

There is a beautiful sentiment in the first two verses of Psalm 107. It reads, “*Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy.*”

Beginning from the end of this passage and working our way backward we find these things to be true:

We have an enemy.

We know that enemy, ultimately, is Satan.

We are redeemed {ga al'} to buy back, from Satan which means we were once his.

Our redemption is from the Lord.

Because we have been redeemed, we are to speak of and give thanks for His goodness.

This passage is an Old Testament example of being vocal about your faith in God. It is about confessing His name (Matthew 10:32-33). It is about letting your light shine (Matthew 5:16). It is about telling folks “Come and see” (John 1:39, 46). It is about sharing your thankfulness for what God has done for you (Revelation 7:12). And, it is about the reason for doing so, our recognition of His goodness. If confessing His name and letting our lights shine and if telling folks to “come and see” and sharing our thankfulness for what God has done for us is in recognition of His goodness, what are we recognizing if we don't do those things?

Knowing what to do to please God has never really been all that difficult to understand. But doing the things we need to do to please God has always been a struggle for man. It takes commitment, conviction and conversion to Christ. I am thankful that it is possible for each of us to be committed, convicted, and converted to Christ!

Remember, I love you in the Lord and want to go to heaven with you.

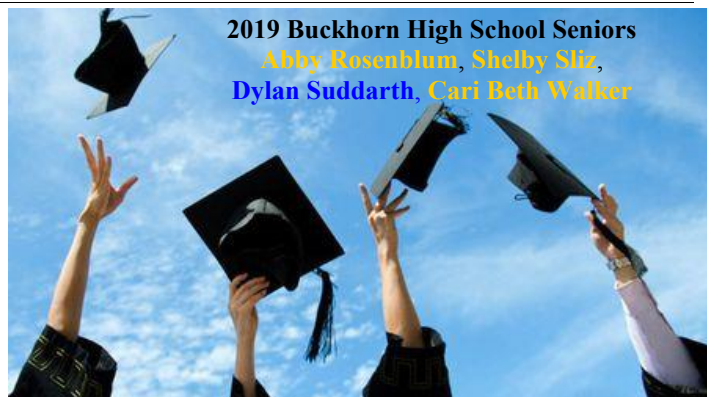
