Summer is in full swing for our Chase Park Youth Group! Two weeks ago we took 45 individuals from Chase Park to Rocket City Youth Camp (RCYC) at Camp Neyati in Guntersville. RCYC is our Area Wide week where Chase Park, Owens Crossroads, Plainview, Broad Street, Arab, and Meridanville assemble for a week of Bible camp. We had 181 in attendance this year and broke a record! Our theme for the week was *Freedom*.
