## He's Still Working on Me

Have you ever had the Vacation Bible School song, "He's Still Working on Me" come to mind? Thoughts along these lines come to mind because it's a catchy tune, but also because we realize we are humans striving to reach the holiness God desires of us. We live in a world where Satan is constantly tempting us, trying to pull us away from following our God. At times we may stumble, but we should be encouraged by Paul's words to the Corinthians, **2 Corinthians 7:1** – *"Having therefore these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God."*

Keep in mind that we are not alone. We have those around us who care and are able to help us grow strong in our faith. Paul wrote in **Ephesians 4:12-13** that there are those with abilities *"<sup>12</sup>for the perfecting of the saints, unto the work of ministering, unto the building up of the body of Christ: <sup>13</sup>till we all attain unto the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a full-grown man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:.."*

Our efforts should be focused on humbling ourselves before God and striving to serve him, instead of being consumed by the affairs of this earthly world. **1 Peter 5:6** - *"<sup>6</sup>Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time."* **2 Timothy 2:4** - *"<sup>4</sup>No soldier on service entangles himself in the affairs of this life; that he may please him who enrolled him as a soldier."*
