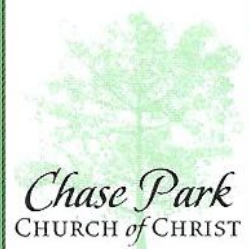

## What Does Thanksgiving Look Like?

I hope and pray that you had a great Thanksgiving. I know it was probably at least a little bit different than previous years, maybe a lot different. There should be within the heart of all Christians a disposition to be thankful to God no matter the circumstances of life. Why? Because God is so good (Matthew 19:17) and has been especially good to His children (Romans 13:4). The past almost 9 months have been incredibly difficult for our country, the world, and the church.

How can we show our thanksgiving when there is no apparent end in sight?

First, we must continue to pray if we believe that *"the effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much."* (James 5:16). Now is a great time to prove to God that you trust Him enough to turn your anxiety over to Him, take it off your plate and drop it off at His throne.

Next, we must act if we believe that *"(He) is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us."* (Ephesians 3:20). Now is a great time to prove to God that you believe He is all-powerful and that He expects us to do our part in the Kingdom of His dear Son (Colossians 1:13).

What does that look like? It looks like being faithful in attendance, study, and as we have mentioned prayer. It looks like sharing our faith in subtle and not-so-subtle ways. It looks like treating our neighbors as ourselves, etc...

In other words; we need to be Christians, because, no matter how cloudy/unclear the immediate future may be, the ultimate future is neither cloudy nor unclear. God will be victorious and so will we if we remain faithful until death (Revelation 2:10). If those Christians in Smyrna could remain faithful through such severe persecution, surely, we can ( and must ) remain faithful through these times.
