Evangelism Update

In Matthew 7:7-8, Jesus says, “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.” This is a promise from our Lord. An honest heart will have an opportunity to accept or reject the gospel if they are truly searching for it.

About a week ago we finished our study with Joseph and Kayla Miller. We started that study last summer in late July. Most Thursday nights, Maria and I would meet at the house of Jamie Elkins (Joseph’s cousin) and Jamie and Beverly Miller would have prepared food for all of us (always eat).

The study was interrupted multiple times by people getting Covid and us not being able to get together. In addition, Joseph had two Grandparents pass away near the end of our study. Shortly after that, Beverly Miller’s mom, Dorothy, passed away. And yet, they kept coming to services, they came to Bible classes, and they stayed engaged through it all.

I wanted to share what went right with this conversion:

1. Jamie and Beverly knew someone that they wanted to share the gospel with.
2. They invited him to come study and he accepted.
3. They provided the food and fellowship that prepares the soil for receptivity.
4. They were planting and watering that soil the entire time.
5. This time allowed Maria and I to connect with Joe and Kayla.
6. It allowed them time to give serious consideration to the gospel and to what they (especially Joseph) had previously been taught and believed.
7. After an extended period with no study because of Covid and other factors, Jamie asked Joseph if he wanted to complete the study (patience) and he accepted.
8. The last study was basically a summary of what we had studied with an emphasis on what baptism does and the uniqueness of the Lord’s church.
9. Joseph obeyed the gospel and is now our brother in Christ.
10. But the story does not end there...
11. Less than one week since he put on Christ in baptism, Joe tilled the soil of a friend, Brad, invited him to study, and we had that study Thursday evening.
12. If I have ever been involved with a study that involved all the aspects needed for a combined effort to win a soul, this was the one.
13. That effort includes you as well. This congregation sent a lot of cards of encouragement and compassion when Joe lost his grandparent, and they meant a lot to him.

Thank you for all your efforts to reach the lost, please make Joe and Kayla feel welcome, and let’s all be on the lookout to share the gospel with someone.
