January 2026 Chase Park Evangelism Update

Brothers and Sisters,

The start of February has been difficult with the weather, and yet there are still people visiting our services and asking questions about Jesus and His church. We have several new convert studies going as well as a few prospects that we are studying with and ones we are trying to set up studies with.

In 2026, there are several things we all can do to help expand the borders of our Lord's Kingdom. One of the easiest is to attend services regularly. The Lord knows when you can't be here for reasons beyond your control, and He knows when you can be here and aren't. But attendance is not about a checklist if you are here or not. It is about showing God how much you love and appreciate Him and His people. When we gather together for services, we are to "stir one another up to love and good works" (Hebrews 10:24-25) which means we are to encourage each other to do the right thing, help when people are in need, and be there for the ones we care about the most, our spiritual family. Beyond that, there is the encouragement factor that affects the prospects and visitors to our services. If they are visiting or agreeing to study the Bible with one of us and they see that attendance is not important to some, it will create a cognitive dissonance in their minds while they are trying to figure out if they want to become Christians and place membership at Chase Park. Rather than helping the cause of Christ for evangelism, this is, in reality, hurting the cause. So, like worship itself, attending services is not about you or me or how we feel, it is about God and what He wants.

My encouragement is to make a commitment to be at services every single time that you possibly can. You just don't know who might need the encouragement that you can provide just by being there, and maybe a hug or a handshake and a short conversation would be just the thing they need as well.
