# Endure! by Faith

Many of us have had to endure difficult challenges during our lives. These challenges may have been physical/health struggles, emotional trials, or spiritual battles. No matter what they have been, our goal has been to endure; yes, and even to overcome.

The most important area where we must endure is in the spiritual aspect of our life. Our theme for this year is "By Faith." That simply encompasses our life, faithful to God and enduring in that faith to the end of this physical life, followed by a reward of eternal life with our Lord.

There will be trials and temptations in our lives. But God constantly encourages us to endure. (**James 1:12:** "Blessed is the man that endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he shall receive the crown of life, which *the Lord* promised to them that love him.") *To endure is to persevere; to remain, i.e., abide, not recede, or flee; bear bravely and calmly.* This ancient definition describes how each of us should be in our lives in relation to our obedience to God's word.

What a pleasant, comforting thought it is when an individual completes their time on this earth and we know they have been a faithful follower of Christ. As we grow in the number of our years in this life, we must grow in our knowledge of God's word which will allow our faith in God to grow stronger. It is often all too easy to be pulled away from Christ by the deceptive temptations of Satan. We need an ever-increasing knowledge of His word and a faithfulness that keeps us by the side of our Master.

We have been challenged recently by Rusty to look at Hebrews 12:1-2. (**Hebrews 12:1-2:** "Therefore let us also, seeing we are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, lay aside every weight, and the sin which does so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, <sup>2</sup>looking unto Jesus the author and perfecter of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.") Reflect on those faithful who have gone before and surround us. Determine that the spiritual things will be your central focus and develop the resolve to endure until your crown of righteousness is received.

**2 Timothy 2:10-12:** "Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sake, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. <sup>11</sup>Faithful is the saying: For if we died with him, we shall also live with him. <sup>12</sup>If we endure, we shall also reign with him. If we shall deny him, he also will deny us."

May we determine that it be said by each of us, "By faith, we made it!"
