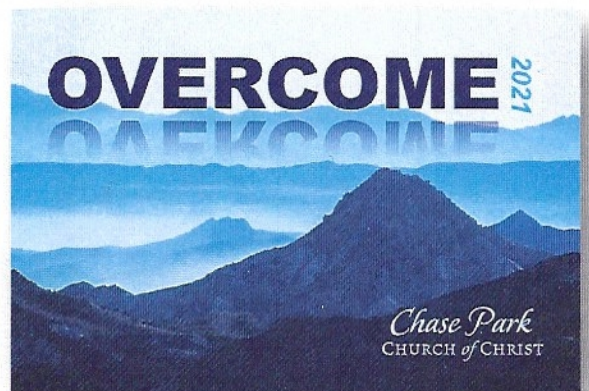

Don't Wear A Mask!

No, unfortunately, I am not talking about the face masks that you and I have become so accustomed to wearing in public. You still need to wear that mask for the time being. I'm talking about a much more dangerous type of mask—a spiritual mask. It is a mask that attempts to hide who we really are from the world around us while it helps us to pretend to be something that we are not. It is a mask of deception and pretense. It is the mask of hypocrisy.

The word “hypocrite” is a familiar word from the New Testament. It is one that Jesus used often as He pointed out the hidden motives and unrighteous acts of the Jewish leaders of the day. In Hellenistic Greek culture, the word *hypocrite* referred to an actor—one who was on stage, wearing a mask and playing a role. The New Testament takes this term and gives it a spiritual meaning—one who puts on a façade of righteousness while being inwardly given over to sin. Hypocrisy was the actions and attitudes of the scribes and Pharisees who “shut up the kingdom of heaven against men” (Matt. 23:13). Hypocrisy was Peter’s eating with the Gentile Christians but then avoiding them when his Jewish brethren were present (Gal. 2:11-13). Hypocrisy is the modern-day Christian who comes to worship on Sunday and makes a show of his religious fervor, and then lives just like the rest of the world throughout the week.

The mask of hypocrisy can take many different forms and be displayed in many different ways. Unlike the protective face masks that we have to wear right now, the mask of hypocrisy is often easy and comfortable to wear and can even be worn without knowing. So, let us all examine ourselves and be sure that we are not wearing a mask of hypocrisy.
