## Shelter In the Storms of Life

As I am writing this, I am watching severe thunderstorms move through the area (Thursday). Days like this can be very unnerving and remind me of why we often refer to difficult times as “storms of life.” Like physical storms, the storms of life can be chaotic and volatile and can create uncertainty and fear in our minds and hearts.
