What a great few weeks it has been since Rob Whitacre and his family were with us at Chase Park. We have had a very good response from the congregation in getting enthused about the effort. Today, Lord willing, we will begin in earnest with our Barnabas Project activities.

- There are two separate meetings today for groups to meet and do things related to encouraging and evangelizing our contacts from our prospect lists.
- We have sent out, that I know of, almost 1200 cards to people who are searching or struggling in one way or another.
- We have had Bible studies multiple times with 10 people and once with two others. Some of those studies are concluding soon and, Lord willing, those people will come to a decision about Christ. Please pray that those searching will obey the gospel.
- We have had two meetings with those who are prepared to hold Bible studies, and with those who are interested. They have been studying materials on how to win souls and how to bring a study to the best possible conclusion.
- We now have over 20 people who are on our contact list in need of prayers, cards, and encouragement. These people are those we will be trying to reach with the gospel first. Some of these people are really hurting from disease or loss of loved ones, please pray for them.

It is encouraging to get reports from the Whitacre's weekly about how other congregations are putting evangelism first in all they do. If you have not been receiving those email updates, please let me know and I will get you on the list.
