Chase Park—Evangelism Update

11/13/2022

A couple of Wednesday's ago in the Devotion for that night, I mentioned a man that I worked with in India a few years ago, Sadguna Rao. He graduated from preaching school in about 1970 and started preaching around his home town of Sri Kakulam, Andhra Pradesh, India. Shortly after he graduated, he was evangelizing in an area that did not have a church of Christ. He helped establish the church there, in Chintuvalasa. I preached in his village while I was there and was amazed to learn that there were about 200 members of this congregation in a village with a population of 125 adults. All 125 adults were members of this congregation.

This past week, about 6 weeks after suffering a stroke, Sadguna Rao spoke there for the 51 year anniversary of the establishment of the congregation. In a village that still only has a population of about 300, there were 70 gospel preachers and 540 people that came to the celebration and worship service on Sunday. This was due to the respect that the surrounding area has for Bro. Sadguna Rao and the work that he does in the community. Two people were baptized last Sunday during the service which brings the total since his stroke to 53 that I am aware of.

All this started because a young man had a desire 50-something years ago to learn the Bible and how to be an effective evangelist. Please be praying for him and his work, and also for us here at Chase Park and for our work. Pray that we might be faithful in handling our opportunities for evangelism, and that we might be encouraging young folks to study the Bible and become evangelists. Who knows? We may have another soul winner like Sadguna Rao in our congregation this morning that just needs a little bit of encouragement to take that step.

Also, we have several studies going right now, please pray for those efforts here locally.

Remember, I love you and want to go to heaven with you.
