For the next 7 days our Chase Park family will be very busy. This weekend is Lads to Leaders in Nashville. Many of our young people have been preparing throughout the year for Lads to Leaders. Last Sunday night many of us had the privilege to hear our young people deliver their speeches and debates, lead songs, read from the Bible, etc. They did a wonderful job and we support them in all their efforts. Throughout this weekend our young people, along with thousands of others, will have a weekend filled with God's Word. There will be many parents and grandparents with smiles on their faces. New friendships will be made among brethren. The church will discover upcoming leaders and servants. Above all, God will be glorified. So thankful for our young people and the Lads to Leaders program.

Additionally, this coming Wednesday, April 20, will be our Ukraine shipping container loading day. It has been overwhelming to see the participation and zeal our congregation has had in gathering items for the Ukraine refugees. Around 800 buckets have been filled, 50 large boxes of hygiene bags have been packed, and numerous items have been donated! On Wednesday, we need as many people that can, to come help load the container, as we ship out all the items. Once the container is loaded, it will be transported to the bay and loaded onto a cargo ship. The shipment will take up to 6 weeks to reach Poland. Once at port in Gdansk, Poland, the container will be unloaded by members of the church from Poland and Ukraine, along with other volunteers. The contents will be distributed to Ukrainian refugees who are in desperate need.

All in all this will be a great week of spiritual growth and service. I'm so thankful to be part of such a loving church family and to serve alongside with you. May God continue to bless the church at Chase Park.
