## *Happy Father's Day!*

*Today is Father's Day so allow me to wish all of our father's a very happy day and express to you a warm "thank you" for all that you do for your families. Writing about Father's Day is a little different for me than doing so about Mother's Day, mainly because I am a father myself, so I can write from my own experiences. When I think about being a father, two things instantly come to mind:*

*The first is **responsibility**. Being a parent—taking on the care, protection, and guidance of children—is definitely a huge responsibility for both father and mother, but for fathers, there is the added knowledge of a God-given duty of being the physical and spiritual head of the household. It is to fathers that God, through Paul, commands concerning children to "bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord." (Eph. 6:4) This verse does not imply that mothers have no place in the training and guiding of children, but it does remind us that, in God's design for the home, the father is ultimately answerable for the leadership of the family. Being a father is certainly a huge responsibility.*

*The second thing that comes to my mind about being a father is **reward**. I am at a point in our family's life when we are getting to see the results of God's blessings and of our efforts through the years. It is so very rewarding to see children who love God and care about others. Don't get me wrong, our children are certainly not perfect and still try our patience on a regular basis, but they are well on their way to being (prayerfully) mature, servant-minded, God-fearing Christian adults. The point is that there are great rewards to seeing children grow up and become what you have always worked toward and prayed for them to be.*

*For those of us who are still involved in raising and training our children, may we understand the great responsibility that comes with that privilege. For those who have completed that task, I hope that you are enjoying the rewards of a job well done. Happy Father's Day to you all.*
